# Action & Discussion Items:

**a) Bike Trek:** Trek Across Maine has requested to use the Eureka Center grounds as a rest stop during their 2018 event and that Durham waive the fee.

Selectman Blake Moves to approve Bike Trek's request to use the Eureka Center grounds as a rest stop and to waive the fee. Selectman George Seconds. Motion carries 5-0.

b) Carol McCoy regarding genealogy book: TABLED

c) Purchasing Policy: moved to later on the agenda

**d)** Fee for dogs impounded at Coastal Human Society: Durham's new Animal Control Officer has recommended the town impose a fee to dog owners to get their dog back after it has been picked up and brought to the CHS. CHS will return the full fee to Durham. ACO recommends a fee of \$50, but the Board agreed they could waive the fee if it presented a hardship to a dog owner. Chairman Nadeau suggests the information be posted on the town website and in the News Blast and put out on social media.

Chairman Nadeau Moves to adopt the \$50 fee for dogs impounded at Coastal Humane Society beginning November 1, 2018. Selectman Beaulieu Seconds. Motion Carries 5-0.
