I am pleased to provide the following updates:

- We have a new Fire Chief –Robert Tripp. His first day will be September 20, 2021. We are pleased to have him join DFR.
- Reminder Bulky Waste Day is this Saturday, September 18th from 8:00 noon. Please be advised that you need to be in line by 11:30. Town Staff and employees from Casella/Pine Tree Waste will be there to assist residents. Tires with rims will be \$4, tires without rims \$7 cash or checks written to the Town of Durham. Please have your cash or check ready before you get to the front of the line. Also, Casella is masking and requiring residents and Town Staff to mask for Bulky Waste Day. The employees assisting at Bulky Waste Day are the same that do the regular trash pick-up- they are trying to protect employees from exposure so that there are no lapses in trash services.
- We are still looking for a Public Works Driver/Laborer. Please come to the Town Office or Public Works if you are interested.
- The work on the Women's restroom has been completed and it is now fully functional

Concerning vehicle registrations, unfortunately the Town will continue to be on the "Limited New" status for BMV until November – the exact date TBD by the State. Our reports are accurate, it is just standard State procedure for Towns with all new staff. We can currently process new registrations if it is a dealer sale, you have paid your sales tax and title fee and are using old plates. We can also issue transit plates, and process re-registrations (which can also be done online). All private sales will require a trip to Durham to pay your excise tax and then continuing to BMV to pay sales tax, get your new plate, and apply for title. All recreational licenses and registrations through MOSES/IF&W can be processed as normal in Durham. Several have asked about snowmobile registrations – we do not get those stickers from IF&W until October. You can re-register online now.

We still have several individuals that have not picked up their allotment of trash tags. Additional tags are available at the Town Office for \$3.00. Also, residents should check and verify that their taxes are paid in full. You can check the status and/or pay online via the Town of Durham website online services or go directly here: <u>https://durham.androgov.com/</u>. Or feel free to call the Town at 207-353-2561. Interest is accruing on accounts that are not paid in full.
